



AAU VOLLEYBALL SUPER REGIONAL & GRAND PRIX TOURNAMENTS

TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES

Following are guidelines of hosting an AAU Super Regional or Grand Prix Tournament.

1. AAU License (Sanction) & Membership

- a. Hosts must submit the AAU Super Regional/Grand Prix Application Form to the AAU National Office. The National Committee will review applications for approval. A limited number of Super Regional and Grand Prix events will be approved. A maximum of one Super Regional and one Grand Prix will be awarded per District.
- b. Once approved, the Host will receive the AAU Event License Application. The application must be returned to the AAU National Office along with the appropriate license fee (\$50 per day). These events cannot be licensed online.
- c. All participants must be members of the AAU (club, athletes and non-athletes). It is the tournament host's responsibility to ensure participants are AAU members. This can be done in the following ways:
 - i. Require teams to complete their roster online at www.aauvolleyball.org and submit a copy of the AAU generated team roster with their entry.
 - ii. Require teams to present proof of membership at check-in which includes an AAU generated team roster, AAU generated club listing or copies of AAU membership cards.
 - iii. If using AES for registration, require teams to import their AAU memberships for validation.
- d. The tournament must be promoted as an AAU-sanctioned tournament. Dual-sanctioned events will not be approved. An event flyer will be required as part of the application process and must include the approved AAU language included.
- e. It is recommended that the tournament take place prior to the entry deadline to Nationals, which is typically the second week in May.

2. Entry Fee Waiver

- a. The winner in each age division with 12 or more teams will receive a free entry fee to the AAU National Championships or the West Coast Championships. If less than 12 teams participate, the entry fee will be adjusted on a percentage basis per the chart below based on the number of teams that participated in that division.

- b. All teams must still register for the AAU National Championships or West Coast Championships by the appropriate entry deadline. Spots will not be automatically held for winning teams. All teams must follow the entry requirements and policies as outlined in the event information packet.
- c. Teams earning a free or discounted entry fee must contact the AAU National Office. If the entry fee has been previously paid, a refund will be issued in the same manner that the entry fee was paid. For example, if the team registered online with a credit card, the refund will be issued to that credit card.
- d. Teams can choose to use their free entry fee for the AAU National Championships or the West Coast Championships.
- e. Teams participating in multiple events can only earn one entry fee for the National Championships and one entry fee for the West Coast Championships. Teams cannot earn multiple entry fees for the same event.
- f. If the first place team has previously won a Super Regional or Grand Prix, the entry fee does not drop down to the second place team. The entry fee will only drop to the second place team if the first place team is not attending the National Championships or West Coast Championships.
- g. The entry fee waiver applies only to the team that won the event. The club cannot apply it towards a different team within the same club.
- h. The National Championships or West Coast Championships are open to all teams meeting the entry requirements, regardless of placement or participation in a Super Regional or Grand Prix tournament.

3. Tournament Structure

- a. The event can be one or multiple days, as approved by the AAU.
- b. Each host can offer one or all age groups, as approved by the AAU.
- c. The AAU National Headquarters will assist each Host, but it is the Host's responsibility for organizing the tournament. The Host may retain all proceeds from entry fees.
- d. Blast emails may be sent from the AAU National Office to assist in promoting the event. Contact the AAU Volleyball department to request a blast email.

- e. Each host must submit a tournament recap to the National Headquarters including list of all participating teams and complete results. This must be submitted within 3 days of the conclusion of the tournament. The National Headquarters will verify the percentages of the entry fees to be awarded to the appropriate teams.

4. Super Regional Guidelines

- a. Any team meeting the AAU membership requirements and rules can participate.
- b. The tournament is open to teams nationwide and not limited to teams within a District or Region. There will be a limited number of Super Regionals conducted, so teams from outside of your District should be invited.
- c. Rules of the AAU National Championships must be followed. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - i. All participants must meet the age requirements.
 - ii. All players must live within the AAU District of their team or in a bordering District, and comply with the guidelines set forth in the AAU Code Book. Adult members are not bound by residence requirements. Hawaii, Alaska and US Territories, including Puerto Rico, do not have bordering Districts
 - iii. The Libero player may serve in one rotation in a set.
 - iv. Boys are not permitted on girls' teams.
 - v. For additional rules, please refer to the AAU Volleyball Handbook and National Championships Rules.

5. Grand Prix Guidelines

- a. Grand Prix events can have participation requirements or restrictions, as approved by the AAU National Volleyball Executive Committee. All participants must meet the AAU membership requirements.
- b. This tournament is intended for teams within a particular District or adjoining Districts to form a regional event.
- c. Rules of the AAU National Championships must be followed (see 4.c), unless approved by the AAU National Volleyball Executive Committee.
